Doctoral Fellowship in Mental Health and Addictions Services

Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA), Ontario is awarding two fellowships valued at up to \$5,000 each to recognize and support mental health and addictions services research. Deadline for applications is Jan. 31, 2019. The winners will be announced in March 2019.

Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a thesis-based doctoral degree program in Ontario and be in good standing. Funds can be used for knowledge dissemination activities (e.g. conference attendance or publication fees), project-specific needs, or stipendiary support of the applicant.

Application Process

1. Complete the 2019 application form for the CMHA Ontario Doctoral Fellowship in Mental Health & Addictions Services (next page).
2. Submit completed application forms or send questions to research@ontario.cmha.ca by January 31, 2019.
3. Applications should include: completed application form, curriculum vitae, official university transcripts, one-page structured project summary, and a letter of support from the student's research supervisor.

- Brief letter of support from current research supervisor (one-page)
- Structured project summary (one-page, max 350 words, 12-point font)
- Curriculum vitae (any format)
- University transcripts (for all degree programs)
- Submit all documents as a single PDF and label with applicants name and year. Please arrange PDF in the following order: 1) completed application form, 2) project summary, 3) CV, 4) supervisor's letter, 5) transcripts

Project summary must include:

- Brief background
- Study objectives
- Research question
- Methods (e.g. study design, planned analysis)
- Ethics statement
- Relevance to mental health
- Relevance to Ontario
- Knowledge dissemination plan (e.g. conferences, papers, media, community outreach)

Curriculum vitae should include:

- Degrees, professional certifications, & other relevant training
- Research experience
- Oral & poster presentations
- Publications record
- Relevant community/advocacy work
- Academic awards and research funding
